Information Concerning the SafeSport Course

We have put together this guide to help you complete the SafeSport course through the U.S. Soccer Learning Center. Please note the following:

- A. The SafeSport course is **only** required if you are age 18 or older. Referees who are age 17 and younger are not required to take SafeSport.
- B. The SafeSport course is a requirement of U.S. Soccer pursuant to U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Committee ("USOPC") policy. It is not a requirement imposed by NRDP.
- C. The course is good for a period of one year and then it must be renewed. The renewal course is considerably shorter.

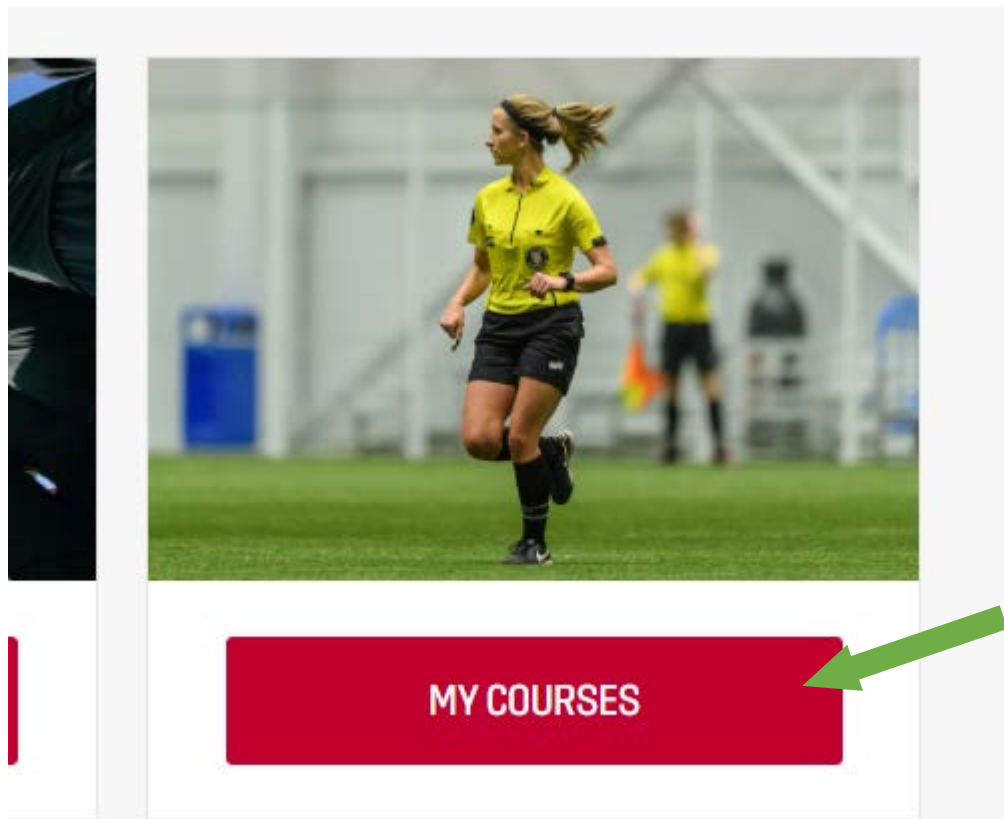

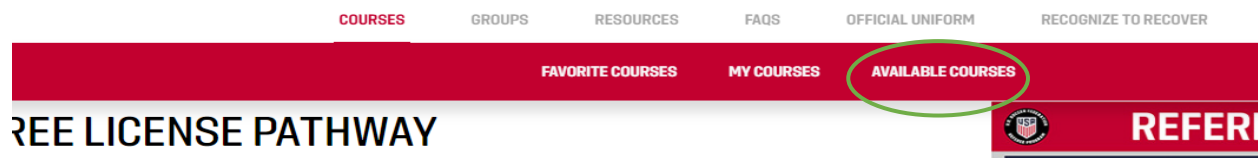


3. Once you have logged in, select on the link at the bottom of the page for the **My Courses**.



4. On the next page, place your cursor over **Courses** at the top of the page and then select **Available Courses**.

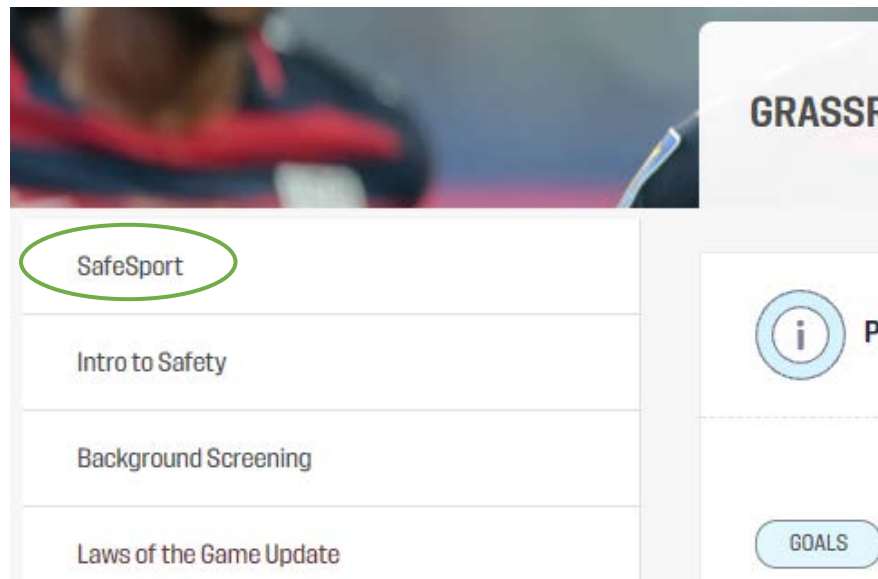


5. Select **Supplemental Courses**.

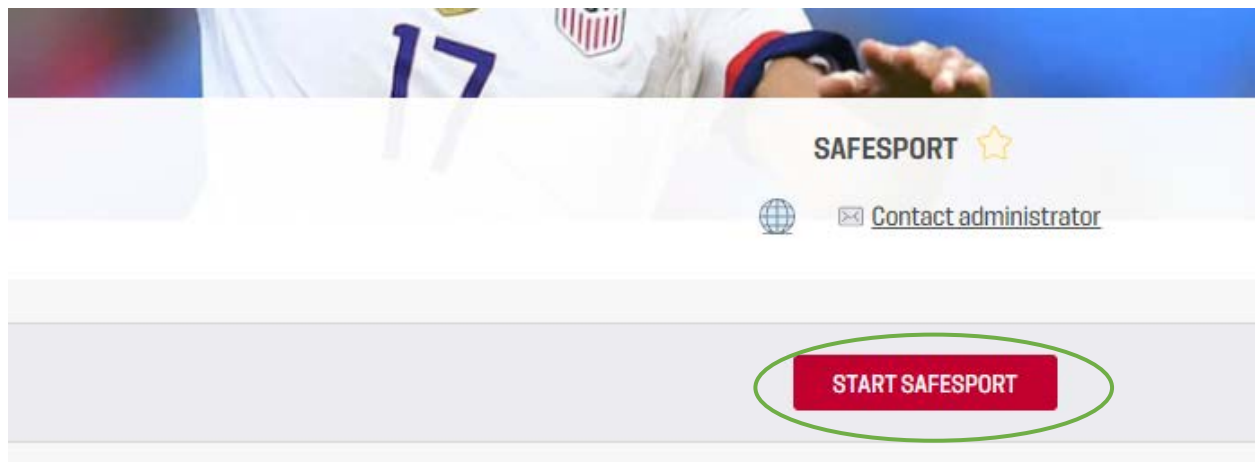
